TITLE:	Apparatus Response –Running Card	O-2

PURPOSE: The purpose of this guide is to establish a procedure for apparatus response to the different types of alarms that the department responds to.

RESPONSE:

- Structure Fire 194, 197, 195, 193, 196, 195-1
- (No Hydrant) 194, 196, 197, 193, 195, 195-1
- Motor Vehicle Fire 194, 195
- Motor Vehicle Crash 195, 193, 195-1
- Medical Emergency 195-1
- CO Alarm / Odor Invest 194, 197
- Outdoor Fire 196, 195-1, 195
- Technical Rescue 195, 197, 195-1
- Investigation 194
- Wires Down / Hazard 195
- Fuel Spill / Hazard 194, 195

Mutual Aid:

- Engine to Scene 194
- Engine to Standby 193
- Engine to Fill Tankers 193
- Manpower / SCBA 195
- RIT / FAST 195 or 197 –officer’s discretion

*Fire Police respond to all alarms in the HFD response area except for medical emergencies. Mutual Aid -special request only.

Condition Red Emergency Response (Sec 1104 V&T Law)
Condition White Non-Emergency Response
